THE MURF REPORT

In the words of the famous comedy team Laurel and Hardy "This is another fine mess you got me into" can be said to Mayor Stevens and council. I have in my possession documents which prove without a doubt just how bad a deal the West St. property is for all of us. I can not understand how any responsible person whether city staff or politician would ever recommend or sign this deal.

Here are some facts unknown at least to me until now. Much has been said about contaminants on this property but no one had ever stated that there is contamination of PCB's, TPH, Antimony, Benzo(a)pyrene, Cadmium, Lead and Ethyl benzene. These are all highly Toxic substances. Troubling is the PCB's which everyone knows is the worst toxin ever produced by man. There is no safe way to get rid of this stuff but this council wants to move it to our dump on the shores of Lake Simcoe.

Fact 2: It was recommended and ignored by council that "prior to use of the subject lands a Site Specific Risk Assessment Approach is required". Estimated cost would be \$250,000 and was never done before signing this deal or even now (but council is spending \$250,000 on drawings without this Risk Assessment). Additionally there is an ORDER from the Ministry of Environment and Energy requiring ground water testing on a regular basis and a requirement of Notification of any potential purchaser to the environmental issues. All seemed to be ignored.

Fact 3: This council in completing this deal agreed that you and I shall be responsible for "the environmental circumstances of the Lands after the closing date and Orillia (you and I) will indemnify and hold harmless Molsons from and against any liabilities, actions, orders, cause of actions, debts and any other obligations whatsoever relating to the Land. This indemnity is referred to as "Orillia's Environmental Indemnity"(translation: You and I).

In the appraisal of this property the mayor and council were warned about the pitfalls of assuming contaminated property. The author of this document states "sophisticated purchasers have

adopted liability avoidance such as obtaining representations and warranties in writing from the vendor" but the advice fell on deaf ears.

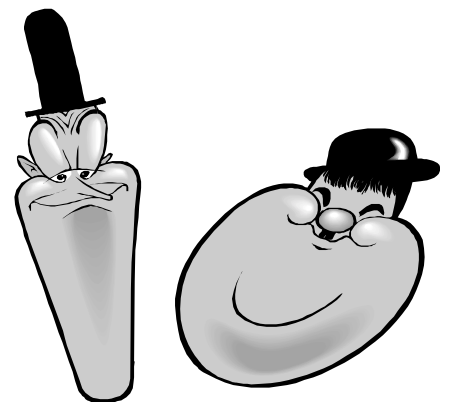
Information passed onto me from a source who had talked to the chairman of the Environmental Advisory Committee who stated that he knew about the PCB. The contamination happened when a transformer exploded some years ago which soaked the surrounding ground with the deadly chemical. If this contamination was known why did council go through with this deal? The chairman also stated that an unnamed company had been dumping barrels of toxic chemicals on the property and was actually caught and fined. If this was known at city hall why on earth did the Mayor and council proceed with this deal?

Folks if as reported these contaminants are indeed present our liability could be into the tens of millions of dollars. Surrounding property owners may have to be compensated as seepage contaminates their property. As stated in the Appraisal "Toxic contamination can lead to substantial liability to the public (you and I) to the extent that such liability runs with the land it is considered a direct loss in property value. The unanticipated release of toxic contaminants onto surrounding properties is an example of the risk."

In the same document interviews with recent purchasers of contaminated properties. "Among all parties interviewed we were unable to find anyone that would suggest a market exists for a site where there is known contamination which has leaked from the property boundaries". So has the contaminants leaked past the boundaries? We need to see the environmental study done on this land. City Hall refuses to release this document. Why? Everyone reading this must contact their councillor and demand full disclosure of the facts immediately. The rush to take possession of this cess pool and the rush to commit millions of dollars to build on it does not make sense. No one contacted with the Environmental Advisory Committee has a copy of any documents on this deal.

WMAC has no information and I will bet that most if not all councillors have never seen the documents in my possession (councillor Morano has stated he never saw the deal). Yet the deal was accepted. If council did have these documents and went ahead with this deal anyway it shows a lack of indifference to all of us.

So what do we do now? Well as in the case of the mis-managed sale of the 12 acres behind WalMart where this council gave away over \$600,000 of Development Fees we are stuck with this land. Molson's made sure that their interest has been protected and we are on the hook. How much could this cleanup cost us? It is anyone's guess. Love Canal cost hundreds of millions. In Kitchener there was a whole subdivision abandoned at a cost of tens of millions dollars. In Scarborough Ont. the old Canada Metal property cost into the tens of millions to cleanup. Can we afford to build on this property? Can we afford to disturb the land and cause toxins to migrate faster to other property? Can we afford not to cleanup the property? As I said at the beginning of this article "Another fine mess you've got us into Mayor and council". Don't you think it's time you councillors started getting these deals and reading them before voting???

Too Honest

In my Help article I told you about meeting Paul Spears at WalMart. During our conversation we touched on the dismissal of Roger Tudhope. Paul stated that he worked well with Roger during his own term on council. His only problem was that Roger's office was filled with clutter. Paul then made a statement which blew my mind. "Roger's problem is that he is too honest". I'm still having a problem understanding how being "Too Honest" can be a problem?

Now I don't believe that Paul himself thinks that honesty is not an asset. I believe he spoke of others in power who Roger was impeding from having thier way. You see Roger worked on our behalf and did his job too well. So what message does this dismissal send to all city employees? The Mayor and council must explain what Roger Tudhope did that was so offensive that he was dismissed after eleven years of exemplary service. Who complained about him?

Environmental Advisory Committee

On Nov. 20 I along with other concerned citizens attended the Environmental Advisory Committee meeting. Doug Peddle and I have been working on a number of questionable deals that the Mayor and council have entered into on our behalf. My investigation led to the sale of land behind WalMart which gave a sweetheart deal to the purchaser. His investigation has now led to the deal with the Molson gift???? to the city of land on West St. for the MURF. Now we are told that the POWER is upset that we have managed to acquire these documents which they wanted kept out of the public's view. We did go through proper procedure and acquired the documents legally. We have passed on this information to candidates of the recent election as well as the Packet and Orillia Today who have chosen to ignore the information and not do their own investigation to inform the public. Councillors were also offered the information. When Councillor Morano was contacted and told of the content of the documents (Molson deal) he became very upset and claimed he was not given this information before voting on it. He also was surprised about the PCB contamination and claimed "these guys told us everything was OK".

Norm Lethwaite the Chairman of the Environmental Advisory Committee was given the documents along with all members including Tim Lauer. Norm was most concerned about the extent of the toxins in the Appraisal document. The committee was never asked for advice nor told about the Nasty Toxins. We were all assured that there was only normal industrial pollution on the site and there was no concern. It now turns out that there is substantial PCB contamination along with Cadmium, Benzines, Lead etc. The Ministry of the Environment has a ZERO PCB tolerance and it will have to be handled by a specially licensed company with workers wearing protective space suits. PCB's must be trucked to a Snowvalley Rd. site outside of Barrie in special

secure trucks where it will be transferred and shipped to a site in Sarnia. From our investigations we have been told that the PCB contamination is very extensive over a wide area of property. Now we do not know the cost of removing this soil per truckload but we do know that there could be thousands of loads involved. This folks won't be cheap. Now that is just the PCB problem.

A number of years ago a local company purchased land at the back of our MURF site wanting to harvest the PEAT. This company was stopped from proceeding because the PEAT was too contaminated. Who at city Hall knew about this mess and kept quiet. Apparently there was an Environmental Study done by Shaheen & Peaker Limited for Molson's back in May 2002 and made available to the Council. According to Tim Lauer this report can not be made public. Tim then claimed that the city did another study of it's own before signing the deal but will not make it available either and then claimed they are doing yet another study right now. Are they trying to get a result they can sell to us? How much are they spending on these studies?

Tim did not seem particularly concerned when I stated "Why would we allow our kids on this site"? Folks we need to secure this area immediately. A fence would be the best solution. I have passed by and have seen people exploring the land. Both adults and children. With PCB's present why are we allowing people to be exposed. Is the POWER so callous that they don't care? One story I have heard actually involves Francis Smith. My source claims this actually happened and he has first hand knowledge. It seems years ago Officer Francis Smith was involved in a foot chase on the West St. Property at night. As he was pursuing the suspect he fell into a hole filled with Liquid Lead. Apparently it was used as a coolant and toxic. Officer Smith was apparently taken to the hospital and de-contaminated?? So if

the story is true (I believe the source as his reputation is impeccable) Councillor Smith should have some first hand knowledge of at least this one toxin. Would appreciate it if Councillor Smith would share his story with us.

Andrew Fyfe who is on the committee told us there are a number of sites as bad or possibly worse throughout the city. Are these properties secured? Will council now tell us where these sites are to protect the public? Every person living and working in Orillia needs to know where the hot spots are. This is a health issue. Maybe the Health Unit could order the city to release these reports as a public safety measure. Exposure to PCB's is very serious and even minute amounts can be harmful. Wouldn't it be tragic if the Mayor and council are with holding this information to save face on yet another deal that does not make any sense.

The end result of the Environmental Committee meeting a request was sent to council to allow the Committee to see these reports in camera if necessary so that they could do their job and advise them on environmental matters.

Doug spoke to a number of candidates about attending the meeting. People who showed up were Doug Peddle, Dennis Edmonds, Nick Montague, Allan Lazier and myself. We have made the effort to hold council responsible and need everyone to do the same. This matter has nothing to do with politics. It is a long three years to the next election. If council does not do the right thing we must hold them accountable. For anyone interested in this deal and Appraisal Report Doug and I would be most happy to let you examine it and explain it's implications. Jim Tolnai
